2010 CMLL Post-Season Baseball Letter of Commitment

Dear Parents and Players,

Cedar Mill Little League (CMLL) is preparing to select players for its 2010 post-season teams. We typically field All-Star and Honors teams for the 9-10 and 11-12 year old tournaments, and will also consider fielding a 10-11 year old All-Star team. All players who are interested in playing on a post season team must return this form to the CMLL League Player Agent – Mike Llewelyn by Thursday, June 3, 2010 – no exceptions will be allowed. Our goal is that every player interested in playing post-season has an opportunity to be considered. Please read the following information carefully before submitting this form. Post season team candidates will be selected based upon their playing ability, eligibility, and availability.

<u>Participation Cost:</u> \$50 per player (if player makes a team). Financial scholarships are available. Player may choose to purchase jackets, windbreakers, and other related gear at an additional expense.

Attendance Requirements: CMLL post-season teams prepare for and play in competitive District 4 tournaments. The level of play at the All Star level is very high and our teams work very hard to maximize their talents to play competitive baseball. Teams may practice two hours a day for 5-6 days per week. Many will also play "tune up" games prior to the District 4 tournament. It is expected that a player selected to a post season team makes that team their #1 priority during that time (typically 2-4 weeks). Any schedule conflicts would have to be cleared with the league prior to selection on the team. The manager of each team, subject to CMLL board approval, has the right to remove a player from a team for lack of attendance. Honors players will also be required to make a significant commitment and they are expected to make their team their #1 priority for the duration of the post season experience.

<u>Tournament Rules:</u> Please note that tournament rules differ from regular season rules. Minimum playing time consists of three defensive outs and one at-bat. Post-season teams do **not** bat the roster. A nine-player batting order is used with National Little League substitution rules in place. **Playing time is not equal and your child will likely not play the same position(s) they played during the regular season.** Please discuss these possibilities with your child **before** you decide to submit their name for consideration to ensure that you and your child do not experience disappointment over playing time and/or position. We would also recommend that you read "All-Stars Experience" on the CMLL website for additional perspective.

<u>Details:</u> The tournament format is typically pool play with the top teams from each pool moving into single elimination play. <u>Tentative</u> start dates for this year's tournaments are listed below for your planning consideration. Tournaments typically require 7 calendar teams to be completed. Be prepared to practice and/or play during the July 4th holiday period. Practice for all teams may begin June 15.

- 9-10 year old All Star baseball team tournament starts June 30
- 9-10 year old Honors baseball team tournament starts June 22
- 10-11 year old All Star baseball team tournament starts July 5
- 11-12 year old All Star baseball team tournament starts July 12
- 11-12 year old Honors baseball team tournament starts June 26

Note: Honors teams do not progress beyond the district level. The 9-10 and the 10-11 year old All-Star tournament winners continue on to state during July. The 11-12 All-Star tournament winners continue on to state, and possibly to the western regionals and The Little League World Series in Williamsport, PA.

- Team rosters and coaches will be selected before June 15th.
- Teams will be announced no earlier than June 15th.
- For 9-10 year old players, a tryout will be held for the Honors and All Star teams on Sunday, June 6th at Findley Elementary at a time TBD. Absence from the tryout will make selection to a team very unlikely, although the reason for the absence will be considered by the selection committee. AAA Division Managers also provide inputs based on player performance during the regular season and vote by ballot to help select 9-10 All-Star and Honors teams.
- Majors Division Managers select 10-11 and 11-12 year old All-Star and Honors players by ballot based on player performance during the Majors Division regular season.
- The CMLL Board will select All-Star and Honors coaches and has final approval of all post-season teams.

2010 CMLL Post-Season Baseball Letter of Commitment

Important

All players chosen for a post season team must provide a valid ORIGINAL birth certificate to the league for team registration. Players without an ORIGINAL birth certificate cannot be considered for a post season team. The birth certificate must originate from the Department of Vital Statistics from the birth state. Photocopies or certificates issued by a hospital are not acceptable.

Players will also be required to certify residency within the CMLL boundary. Players are NOT eligible for All-Star teams if they live outside the CMLL boundary. Parents of all children participating on one of the post-season teams are required by Little League Baseball, Inc. to provide three documents as proof of residency within the Cedar Mill Little League boundary.

Your application must be received by CMLL's Player Agent no later than June 3rd, 2010 to be considered for post-season play.
